

COOPERATE FOR 'TAMKANG' S FOURTH WAVE

TKU will hold academic year 2004' s Conference on Teaching and Administration Innovation at Chueh-sheng International Conference Hall at 9 a.m. this Friday (October 22); about 200 will attend the conference.

The agenda of the conference, hosted by President Flora C.I. Chang and supervised by Founder Dr. C.P. Chang, is "Welcome Tamkang' s Fourth Wave." Six administrative heads will give reports in the morning, including Department of Chinese' s Professor Fu Hsi-jen ("Reorganizing and Revitalizing Departments"), Assistant Researcher Hou Yung-chi from Center for Higher Education Research and Evaluation ("A Comparison of the Development of Employment System in Taiwan and USA"), Chair of Personnel Office Lo Yunn-chyr ("Reflections on the Establishment of a Flexible Employment System"), Dean of College of International Studies Tai Wan-chin ("The Development of Globalization and TKU' s Work for the Fourth Wave of Internationalization"), Chair of Center of Information Processing Huang Ming-da (TKU, Digital Genesis, Digital Migration"), and Chair of Graduate Institute of Futures Studies Chen Kuo-hua ("Strategic Thinking on New Generation").

Two sessions of discussion on "Welcome Tamkang' s Fourth Wave," moderated by Vice President for Administrative Affairs Kao Po-yuan and Vice President for Academic Affairs Feng Chao-kang, will be held in the afternoon. Round-table discussion, moderated by President Flora C.I. Chang, will be held one and a half hours later; two vice presidents will give conclusive reports on the group discussions and all participants will join the discussion.
