TEMPLE UNIVERSITY IS TO REACH A DUAL DEGREE AGREEMENT WITH TKU

Temple University (TU) is expected to be the sixth university signing a dual degree agreement with TKU. Professor Hai-Lung Dai, together with three of his colleagues, arrived last Friday morning (Mar 14) to discuss the necessary protocol for a 3 +2 dual degree program (i.e., three year at TKU and 2 at TU, receiving a Bachelor's degree from TKU and Master's degree from TU at the end of the study) and sister university agreement. With the finalization of the agreement, TU will become TKU 101th sister university.

Currently there are 5 sister universities having this 3+2 dual degree program agreement with TKU that include University of Jean Moulin, Lyon3 and Michigan University, Flint.

The disciplines that can be the beneficiaries of the 3+2 agreement with TU are Departments of Chemistry, Computer Science and Information Engineering, Water Resources & Environmental Engineering, International Trade, and Global Politics and Economics of Lanyang Campus. Accordingly, Professor Hai-Lung Dai will meet the deans of the related colleges to discuss details.
