

CROSS-STRAIT FORUM ON DEVELOPMENT OF CULTURAL COMMUNICATION AND CREATIVE CULTURAL INDUSTRY WAS HELD ON OCTOBER 13

A cross-strait symposium, “Forum on the Development of Cross-strait Cultural Communication and Creative Cultural Industry,” was held on October 13, 2:30 p.m., at Carrie Chang Fine Arts Center. The mainland delegates, including Liao Ching, Chair of Chiang Shu Association of Philosophy and Social Sciences, Director of Chiangnan Critique magazine, and 12 scholars will discuss with representatives of Dept. of Chinese, TKU, and Wen Hsun magazine.
