

BEIJING CAPITAL NORMAL UNIVERSITY DELEGATION VISITED TKU

Led by Vice President Jian-she Zhou, a delegation of 10 from Beijing Capital Normal University visited TKU on Dec. 17. TKU International Affairs Vice President Wan-chin Tai and others received them at T306.
