

DELEGATION FROM TAMIU VISITED TKU ON JUNE 7

Led by Dr. Pablo Arenaz, Vice President of our sister university Texas A&M International University (TAMIU), a delegation of 4 from TAMIU visited TKU on June 7. Dr. Lee Pei-wa, Director, Office of International Exchanges and International Education, indicated that TAMIU just became TKU' s sister university in January this year, and she hoped their visit could contribute to the academic agreement between the two schools and hence further the mutual relationship.
