

A Conference on the “China Effect” and the Future of “New Asia”

On April 26 - 27, the TKU Graduate Institute of Future Studies held the International Conference on the “China Effect” and the Future of “New Asia”. The conference explored the rise of China as a major international presence and the impact this will have on Asia’s future, and featured distinguished overseas scholars, such as Joon Shik Park (the Dean of the Global Education Institute, Hallym University); professor SchoolCruz from the Philippines, and Professor Feng Xiaotian from China’s Nanjing University.
