

2012 Conference on East Asian Finance

Over two days (May 26, 27) at the TKU Tamsui Campus, a major conference on East Asian finance drew scholars from over 10 countries, including Japan, the Czech Republic, America, Canada, Australia, and Korea, among others. A total of 60 plus academic papers were presented over the two-day event.

A number of special lectures were also delivered during the symposium, by high profile scholars such as Kuan Chung-ming (Minister Without Portfolio, Executive Yuan), Sheng-Cheng Hu (Academician, Academia Sinica), and Dr. Her-Jiun Sheu (President, National Chi Nan University).

One of the attendees, Professor William T. Lin from TKU' s Department of Banking and Finance, stated that the largest breakthrough made at the symposium was the promotion of substantive academic interaction between countries with newly emerging markets.
