

Spotting an Eclipse at Tamkang

At 6:08am on May 21, an eclipse occurred. To get a proper glimpse of the rare event (which occurs once every 54 years), Assistant Professor Chin Yi-Nan, from TKU's Department of Physics, set up a powerful telescope in front of the Shao-Mo Memorial Swimming Complex at 5am and invited early-rising students and passersby to join him in observing the skies.
