EVALUATION OF STUDENT CLUBS PARTIALLY CANCELLED

The planned implementation of evaluation of student clubs from May 31 through June 2, 2003 has partially been cancelled due to SARS. In order to prevent SARS from further spreading, the activity has shrunken into two days but the evaluation and tea party will be held as scheduled. The indoor exhibition will be cancelled while those outdoor exhibitions and award presentation ceremony will be postponed until next academic year.

The evaluation of student clubs and data exhibition has usually been held at Student Activity Center in the past years. Due to SARS spreading in Taiwan, the Extra-curriculum Activities Section (EAS), Office of Student Affairs (OSA) has decided not to open the data exhibition to students this year. With the exception of judges, staff members of EAS and working members of Student Association, no students will be permitted to enter the exhibition site. Therefore, the clubs need not send their personnel to introduce when judges are giving marks on evaluation data presented by student clubs.

Besides, the indoor exhibition was cancelled, while the outdoor exhibition and award presentation ceremony will be postponed until next academic year when student clubs are recruiting new members in exposition in September. Although the award presentation will be postponed, the name list of award winners will be published in homepage of EAS and its Bulletin Board in a week after the evaluation is held.

Although the majority of activities were cancelled, the tea party will be held as scheduled. It will be held at Chueh-shuen Garden from 10:30am to 2:00 pm Saturday. Presidents and ex-presidents of Student Clubs will be

invited to take part in the party. The presentations of manufacturing companies will be held at Room V101 from 7:00 pm to 9:00 pm Thursday. Manufacturers will explain their preferable system on working T-shirt, departmental T-shirt, social service T-shirt, propaganda poster, banner and gifts for activities.
