The Dean of the College of Foreign Languages and Literatures, Dr. Wu Hsi Deh, stated that "the biggest winners in this joint venture are the students, because it allows them to gain experience in the workplace and get a feel for market trends even before graduating.

Under the initiative:

- 1. Each department in the college will explore the needs and requirements of Mandarin learners in their own language of specialization
- 2. The College will equip Chinese teachers with skills necessary to teach learners from a variety of cultural backgrounds; and
- 3. Each department will help to develop innovative teaching resources for Mandarin instruction.
