
Alice Chang Talks Mathematics at Tamkang

Alice Chang is a Chinese American Mathematician who previously won the Ruth Lyttle Satter Prize in Mathematics. She is currently the Chair of the Department of Mathematics, Princeton University, and an academician at Taiwan's premier research institute, Academia Sinica.
