

## **The Annual Academic and Administration Meeting Discusses TKU' s International Standing**

This year the topic was Mixed Development and Raising the International Standing of the University. In attendance was President Flora Chia-I Chang, three university vice presidents, directors and secretaries.

This year they invited alumni from the Office of Quality Assurance and Audit, Yung-chi Hou, to discuss the standing of higher learning institutes internationally. His speech was divided into four main parts that pertain to a universities international standing: uniqueness, student enrollment, academic alliance and employee morale.

Dean of the College of Education, Dian-fu Chang, and Vice President of International Affairs, Wan-chin Tai, laid out the strategy to raise the current international standing of Tamkang University. The discussion included concrete methods of raising the university' s reputation internationally, raising research development methods, and improving the quality of international personnel. Later an informal discussion on implementing these methods was hosted by President Flora Chia-I Chang.
