A European academic tour led by Pres. Chang Horng-jinh and Dr. Feng Chao-kang, V.P. for Academic Affairs was concluded successfully, ending in a signing potential with the time-honored University of Paris-Sorbonne as well as the University of Jean Moulin, Lyon 3 for a possible joint Ph.D. Studies, with which a student from Tamkang, under the guidance of advisors from the above two universities, could take courses and complete his dissertation writing in due course.
